Notice of Interest in Transfer**

Completion of the following form does not guarantee consideration for transfer admission. Each notice of interest is considered individually if transfer seats become available.

Transfer students will only be considered for the beginning of the second year of veterinary medicine only if transfer seats become available in that class. To be considered, you must have completed, up to the time of requested transfer, a course of study consistent with the curriculum of the University of Illinois College of Veterinary Medicine (review our curriculum at www.cvm.uiuc.edu/admissions/curriculum). The Office of Academic and Student Affairs will review submitted curricula for congruency. If invited to apply for a transfer position you will submit (among other documents) detailed course descriptions of all veterinary medicine courses taken, three letters of recommendation and transcripts from all **post** high school institutions you have attended.

To be considered for transfer, a student must present credentials for **pre-professional work** that fulfills the University of Illinois College of Veterinary Medicine requirements for first year entry. Minimum admission requirements include:

- *minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75/4.00(**doesn't include veterinary work**)
- *minimum science GPA of 2.75/4.0 (**doesn't include veterinary work**)
- *results of a Graduate Record Examination General Test completed within the last two years
- *a minimum of 60 s.h. of undergraduate course work that includes completion of the following (with no grade lower than a C-): 8 s.h. of biological sciences with laboratories; 16 s.h. of chemical sciences, including biochemistry; and inorganic and organic chemistry with laboratories; 8 s.h. of physics with laboratories; 3 s.h. of English composition and 3 additional semester hours of English composition and/or speech; 12 s.h. of humanities and/or social sciences; and 12 s.h. of junior/senior level (or graduate level) science courses. *All course work must have been completed at a regionally accredited United States college or university.*

IMPORTANT NOTE: Do not submit any credentials at this time. You will be notified in the late Spring (June) if transfer opportunities are available and at that time a list of necessary credentials will be requested. You must be in good academic standing at the veterinary school at which you are currently enrolled.
